11. AIRLINE OFFICE RENTAL (TERMINAL)	Basis: monthly rent € 100 per m ²

1. Services Covered by Basic Handling

RAMP HANDLING:

- Aircraft guiding to parking position and parking
- Placing and removing of wheel chocks and passenger steps
- Ground Power Unit connection, disconnection, and 30 minutes usage
- Placing standup to by fire extinguisher
- Guiding passengers to and from aircraft
- Luggage, cargo and mail loading and unloading
- Luggage, cargo and mail loading transportation to and from terminal building
- Ballast loading and unloading
- Aircraft and toilet cleaning and disinfection
- Fresh water tanks
- Fresh water tanks supplying
- Aircraft towing up to pushing to start position
- Tow bar and pushup to back vehicle placing up to removing
- Marshall signalization during starting of aircraft engines
- Supply nitrogen and oxygen

PASSENGER AND BAGGAGE HANDLING:

- Preparation, production and distribution of traffic documents
- Providing audiovisual information regarding arriving and departing time
- Receiving and sending of telex messages
- Checking of passengers and their baggage
- Delivering baggage, cargo and mail
- Assistance to transfer, transit and handicapped passengers
- Providing first medical aid and sick passenger transportation
- Dealing with lost and found of baggage, cargo, and mail
- Providing all necessary communications
